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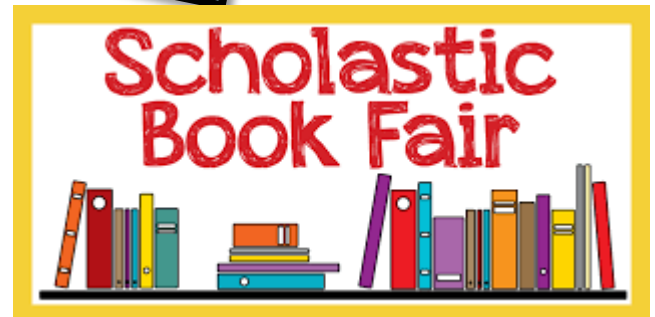
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Uniform Reminder: We appear to still be reminding the children about earrings, particularly on PE days when the children are not able to remove their own studs.
