Year 3 - Roman Skeletons workshop

Year 3 enjoyed an interactive virtual session about Roman skeletons on Tuesday 10th May with the Museum of London. We also had a tour of the Roman gallery at the Museum of London, which we are very excited to visit in June!

Practicing our sounds isn't as boring as call and repeat! We play lots of fun phonics games outside and really impress our teachers.
