A Spotlight on Year 2

We have been very busy in Year 2. On Monday we had a workshop on 'Road Safety'. This workshop links with our shared reading book called 'Hodgeheg' by Dick King Smith, where Max the hedgehog wants to find out how to safely cross the road without getting hurt. The class really enjoyed the workshop and applied their learning into their work based on 'Hodgeheg'.



In our computing lessons, we are focusing on the topic of 'statistics' and we have been learning how pictograms provides us with data.
