Science week is just around the corner with a whole school experiment and visiting scientist on the cards.

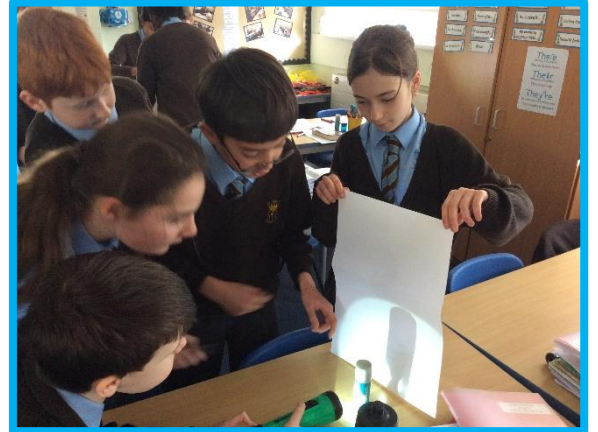
And over the next couple of weeks, the reception children will welcome their own fluffy yellow visitors so make sure to check back for some pictures!

A Spotlight on Year 6.

This week we finished our science topic about light with some investigations. On Monday, we investigated how shadows change depending on the distance of the object from the light source.



On Wednesday, we found out how light can be refracted by placing a pencil in a glass of water and observed that it appeared to be broken. Next, we investigated how we see colours by placing coloured filters over our drawings.



In English, we revised our knowledge of different word classes. We worked together to sort a variety of words which prompted some discussion about how some of the words could belong in more than one category.
